Community Voting for Executive Committee Members

Voting Eligibility- Property owners that are dues paying members. Must be 18 yrs. old or older. If member joined in the household category all members 18 and older in the household can vote. Eligible voting members must be present at the meeting to vote.

Candidacy Eligibility- Same as voting eligibility.

Quorum to have vote- 10 dues paying members from the community having the vote.

Chair of Meeting- The senior member from the community having the vote from the executive committee. Chair of the Meeting will appoint two tellers (collectors) that will distribute and collect ballots. The Chair of Meeting will also appoint one of the two tellers/collectors as the Chair of the Tellers/Collectors. The members running for the Executive Community can observe the tellers/collectors as they distribute and collect ballots if they want to. The Chair of Meeting will give the instructions below to voting members on how to vote.

Ballot- The ballots will have the names of the candidates running for resident or non-resident positions on them. For resident candidates voters will **circle ONLY 2 NAMES**. For non-resident candidates voters will **circle ONLY 1 NAME**. The top 2 vote getters running for the resident category will win and the top 1 vote getter will win in the non-resident category. Voters will fold their vote and hold until the teller/collector collects the vote after the Chair of Meeting declares voting over after asking if any voting members in attendance did not vote and want to. **Do not fold more than 1 ballot together if more than one household member is voting**. If someone circles 3 or more names in the resident category or 2 or more in the non-resident category that vote is void and will not be counted. Misspelled words do not void a vote/ballot.

Collection of Ballots- When the Chair of Meeting declares voting ended, they will instruct the teller/collectors to collect the ballots. Candidates can observe the collection if they want to. The teller/collectors will then count the votes, write the votes cast for each candidate and the total number of votes (report). The Chair of tellers/collectors will then read the report, they will not declare a winner, to the Chair of Meeting and the Chair of Meeting will declare a winner after checking the report. Chair of Meeting will then give the secretary the report.

Eligible Candidates will have to sign that they received these procedures.
